ECONOMIC TRANSFORMATION¹

- Sasol's contribution² to the SA's GDP is **> 5%**
- Sasol is one of the largest taxpayers in SA (**~R 52.6 bn in 2022**)
- **R 38.8 million** has been spent by Sasol to develop SMEs³
- Sasol has provided funding of **R 98 million** to 19 suppliers
- **R 41.7 billion** of procurement costs have been paid to Black-owned businesses and
- **R 28.5 billion** to Black women-owned businesses.



SOCIAL TRANSFORMATION

- Sasol supports **>3%** of SA's total employment² (**500 000 jobs**)
- A total of **R526 million⁴** of social investment was spent by Sasol in 2022 on areas such as:
 - Quality Education **~ R176.1 million**
 - Bridge to Work skills **~ R123.7 million**
 - Community Service Health and Infrastructure **~ R120.9 million**
 - Environment and Biodiversity **~ R7.6 million**
