Uncommitted Capacity in Sasol Gas Transmission Pipelines

In terms of section 4 (d) of the Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) ("Gas Act"), NERSA determined the level of uncommitted capacity in Sasol Gas transmission pipelines.

Sasol Gas confirms that there is uncommitted capacity in its transmission networks (SWM, GTN and GNP), which is subject to the third party access provisions as contained in the applicable operating licenses for its transmission facilities in terms of Section 21(1)(d) of the Gas Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). The available spare capacity in the network is dependent on where in the network it is injected and finally delivered and will be guided by the Sasol Gas Network code as per Regulations 6(11) of the Piped Gas Regulations.
